Conducted 5,000 surveys among residents in The Auto Club Group territory

- o Fielding took place June 16 25, 2021
- o Utilized a proprietary online research panel
- Weighted by age and gender within state

- o Impact of the COVID-19 Pandemic on Travel Plans and Preferences
- o Q3 (July-September) Travel Plans
